Please adhere to the following guidelines for the submission of your paper for the MBD-2022 Conference and email one electronic copy of your paper in Microsoft Word format and also in PDF format to: mbd.info2021@gmail.com

1. Basic Requirements

Papers must be submitted in English. Papers should be as compact as possible and include title, authors and their affiliations, abstract, text, section headings (such as introduction, experimental results, discussion, conclusions, etc.), tables, figures and references.

Papers will be reviewed by members of the Technical Committee for technical merit, scientific content, and relevance to the theme of the MBD-2022 Conference.

2. Format

Please comply with the formatting requirements for your Paper.

Page layout: Size: Letter (8.5" x 11");

Margins: left, right, top and bottom: 1 inch

Font: Constantia, Size normal text: 11 point.

Paragraph:

Alignment normal text: Justified;

Indentation: 0

Spacing: Before and after paragraph: 6 points

Line spacing: Single.

3. Title

Paper title should be brief and simple, and should contain the essence of the paper. Punctuations and abbreviations are to be avoided.

Font: Cambria 14 pts, Bold.

4. Name of Author/Authors

Author: Font Constantia- size 11 (Bold)

Professional Designation of Author/Authors: Font Constantia- size 11.

Email address of the corresponding author: Font Constantia- size 11.

5. Abstract and Keywords

The word Abstract should be in **Bold**, Constantia 11 pt font, centered with 1 blank line above and below, separating it from the abstract text of **500** words maximum.

All **keywords** are to be marked in '**Bold letter**'. A maximum of **6 key words** per abstract is recommended.

6. Main Text

6.1. Sections

Titles of sections and subsections (introduction, experimental, results, discussion, conclusions, etc.) should all be in **bold** and aligned to the left margin with one blank line above, separating the title of each section from the preceding text and one blank line below separating it from the following text.

Numbering of titles of sections and subsections (if any) should be according to the number format used in the current document (1.1, 1.2, 1.3, etc.)

6.2. Equations

All equations will be centered (using a center tab position) and a sequential number in parenthesis will be at the right-hand side of each equation (using a right tab at position 14 cm). A preceding and succeeding blank line should separate them from the text.

For example:

$$F = m \cdot a \quad (1)$$

where

F	Force (N)
m	mass (kg)
a	acceleration (m/s ²)

7. Tables, Figures and Illustrations

Tables, figures and illustrations should normally be inserted at the appropriate position in the paper. Arabic numerals are to be used for numbering tables.

Table headings shall be bold and centered and placed on top of the related tables.

Figure captions shall be bold and centered and placed below the related figures.

All figures (photographs, drawings, diagrams) should be numbered with consecutive Arabic numerals in the same order as they are referred to in the text. (Fig. 1.; Table 3: etc.)

Photographs shall have, where relevant, a scale marker to show magnification.

The maximum size of illustrations is 5.5 inches x 8 inches.

8. References

All publications cited in the text should be presented in alphabetical order in the list of References following the text of the manuscript. In the text, refer to the author's name (without initials) and year of publication as shown ("Demir F., (2008)" for single author, "Puri R and Yee D (1990)" for two authors and "Mazzotti M, (2009)" for more than two authors.

9. Other remarks

- No headers and footer are to be used.
- Abbreviations should be defined twice before use. Note: There is no need to define common abbreviations referring to chemical formulae and units of measure.
- The SI system of units should be adhered to.
